- 43% increase in submissions
- Management Research is **indexed, abstracted** and **ranked** by
- ABI INFORM; AIDEA 2015-2016 Journal Rating; Cabell's Directories of Publishing Opportunities in Management; EBSCOhost; Excellence in Research for Australia (ERA) 2015; QUALIS 2016; Latindex Directory; Summon; ProQuest; ReadCube Discover; Thomson Reuters; Emerging Sources Citation Index; TOC Premier
- Under review for inclusion in SCOPUS and Latindex
- Record number of article downloads (Over 15K in 2015)
- First issue based on focal article with commentaries to be published in 2016
- Two special issues in process, 1 more expected
